Production –verses- Test

Dear LTA Hotel/Car Customer:

With the new changes that were made in March for the Galileo sessions, Lanyon thought it was a good idea to explain how each system works for production and test sessions.

Apollo and Galileo – AGENCY SESSIONS

This requires a separate terminal address session for production and test systems.

Apollo and Galileo – VENDOR SESSIONS

Production only.

CarMaster/RoomMaster –

After connecting to the session you can type in CAR or RMS for production and CV21 for test.

NOTE: It is very important to understand that you have signed into test as the system does not display this in anyway.

Amadeus Access –

This requires a separate terminal address session for production and test systems.

Worldspan Access –

This requires a separate terminal address session for production and test systems.

Sabre Access –

After connecting to a Sabre terminal address session for production, you type in ꞖꞖTSTS to be in test and ꞖꞖRES to move back to production. If you sign out of the session it will automatically sign you out of test.
